Chicago Style Format for Papers | Requirements & Examples

While The Chicago Manual of Style does not include a prescribed system for formatting headings and subheads, it makes several recommendations. Maintain consistency and parallel structure in headings and subheads. Use headline-style for purposes of capitalization. Subheadings should begin on a new line.

General Format // Purdue Writing Lab

Chicago papers start with a title page. The title of the paper should be 1/3 of the way down If there is a title and subtitle, the two should be on different lines, separated by a colon. About 2/3 of the way down the page should contain your name, the date, and any other information required by your instructor.

Sample Paper Using Chicago Manual of Style ...

Center the title of your page around half-way down. If your paper has a subtitle, end the title line with a colon and place the subtitle on the next line. Center your name directly under the title. Center your teacher ' s name, course title, and date, in three separate lines, directly underneath your name.

Paper Formatting - Chicago Style Guide, for 17th Edition ...

Double-space the text of the paper. Use left-justified text, which will have a ragged right edge. Do not use fully (newspaper-style) justified text. Use a 1/2" indent for paragraph beginnings, block quotes and hanging (bibliography) indents.

Chicago style paper format suggests the following set of guidelines for headings and subheadings: You can capitalize the Chicago style paper heading (s).
